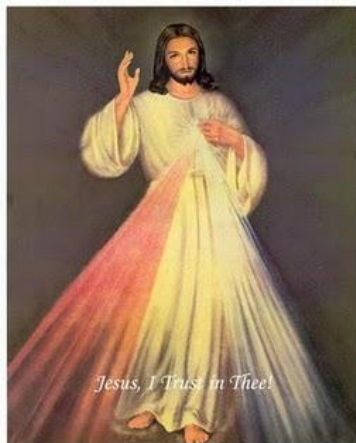

What is the history of the Divine Mercy Image? Saint Faustina of the Most Blessed Sacrament was canonized as the very first saint of the 3rd

millennium by Pope John Paul II in Rome on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 30th, 2000. Saint Faustina was called to sanctity at a very early age and entered religious life with the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Poland in 1925. On Sunday, February 22, 1931, Jesus appeared to her with bright rays of light emanating from His heart. He said to her *“Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You! I desire that this image be venerated... in your chapel, and... throughout the world”* (47). Jesus went on to exclaim, *“I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over [its] enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My own glory* (48).

✦ As of September 30, the Grade 1, Kindergarten and Pre-School children have collected \$12, \$68, and \$137 respectively for each class for their Together Vision Gifts. The final count will be announced next week after all donations are received this weekend when Bishop Michael Jackels visited. As a school, the children may have altogether raised a little over \$1,000.--!!! Thank you to everyone’s support & generosity.

Did you know...

✦ That our students who are determined to have a disability under the Individuals with Disability Act are eligible to receive special education services at no cost through the public school system. The ANW Special Education Cooperative will provide free screenings based on referrals from our school staff and/or parents that

will assist in determining eligibility and need for those services. In addition, special education pre - school screenings are held each month in Iola and Chanute. Please contact Mrs. Fey Barles if you want services or testing for your child.

- ✦ That the Kindergarten, Grade 1 and Grade 2 Classes are scheduled for DIBELS Testing this October? Kinder will be on October 6-7. Grades 1 and Grade 2 will be on October 12-14.
- ✦ The Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Tests for Grade 3 are on T-W-Th Oct 5-7. Please make sure that your child is well-rested with a good night’s sleep and has eaten breakfast and comes to school on time and in good spirit. Please coordinate with your child’s teacher if you have questions.
- ✦ That students need to start choosing the Saint they will study, dress up like and share about for the upcoming October 29 All Saints Day Celebration and School Program, “Festival of Prayers, Poems and Rhymes?” Families are invited to watch the school program in the gym from 10:00 AM - 12:00 noon.
